Alan Vollweiler Becomes PPSNYS President



WPPA V.P. **Alan Vollweiler** became President of our state organization on May 1 and the gavel was passed from outgoing president Monroe

Payne at the May 7th Executive Council meeting in Binghamton, NY.

Two major events confronted the new President on day one. The first was the unexpected separation of the Central section from PPSNYS. The announcement came from Central's President Kelvin Ringold who read a departure letter at the meeting. The second item was the formation of a

PPSNYS Revitalization Action Team. Two and a half hours was devoted to the re-energizing effort. Many good ideas were discussed and Alan has started to put together committees to tackle the issues. A PPSNYS President letter will be going out to members in May.

Here are the significant motions that were passed at the meeting:

FocusNY will be held once again at Villa Roma on March 2-4, 2019.

The PPSNYS Annual meeting will be on March 3, 2019 at Villa Roma.

WPPA's Aspiring membership will cost \$160 for 12 months, a \$90 discount.

Sections continue to be supported by the state with a \$200 payment if they have a an all day TEP.

Alan is asking all members to get involved in growing the organization. One person can not make the changes needed to improve PPSNYS. It will take an effort from all of us.
